At its 24 February 2010 meeting, the KFL&A Board of Health considered its continued involvement with providing services under Part VIII of the *Building Code Act*. At this meeting the Board of Health made the decision to continue to be the service provider for this program as a service to residents of the KFL&A area and to our municipal colleagues. The Board acknowledged, however, that because the fee structure that is currently in place does not fully pay for this service, they will consider a revised fee structure at their next meeting. It is clear, however, that fees for this program will increase in this area, to levels that are charged in other parts of the province.
