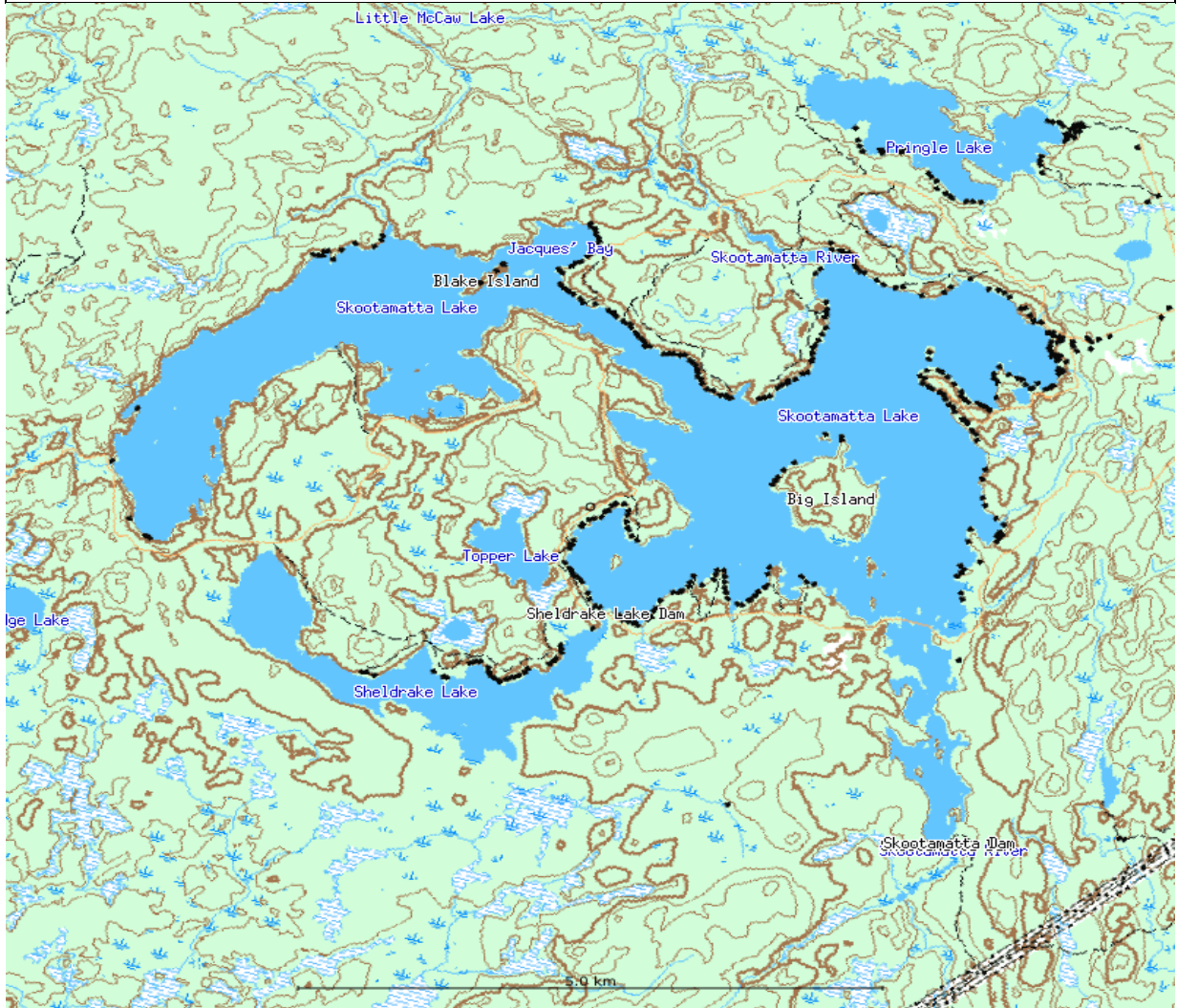

**We need you to influence the quality of life on Lake Skootamatta, Sheldrake and Pringle.** By building our own leadership and awareness, we CAN influence the future for the Lake so that the quality of life, for all of us, is maintained or improved. Are you concerned enough to provide your thoughts and views? **We want you to have a say and make your voice and opinions heard. Are you concerned about the lake's future? Do you have particular issues you feel have not been voiced by anyone else? Without hearing from you we lack guidance to act on your behalf. Please take the time to make your views count. Now is the time for YOU to make a difference.**

At the Summer AGM of the SDRA (Skootamatta District Ratepayers Association) the membership voted for the establishment of a committee to pursue the creation of a Lake Management Plan for Skootamatta. At the same time we were addressing the issues related to an RFP (Request for Proposal of Development) for an area on Sheldrake Lake and very close to Skootamatta. The SLA (Sheldrake Lake Association) has partnered with us to publish this survey that is intended for completion by all residents, business owners, associations and for review and input by Township, ministries(MNR, QCA) with interests in this water community.

This survey has been prepared to ensure that a **wide range of views and ideas are considered as we move toward a Lake Management Plan for our lake within our watershed.** (A watershed is the region draining into a river, river system, or other body of water. Our lake ultimately drains into the Bay of Quinte and we are the upper region of the Quinte Watershed.) In order to make sure we have enough clean water for drinking and other uses, we need to protect sources by managing the influences upon them. The best way to protect sources of water is on a watershed basis because water flows across the traditional boundaries of townships and counties. Conservation Authorities are the only watershed management agencies in Ontario that are organized on a watershed basis. Ours is the Quinte Conservation Authority and we are at the headwaters.

**The objective and intent of the survey is to identify *what you think is important* as a member of the Skootamatta, Sheldrake & Pringle community, or someone with a vested interest in the area.**

- What would you like to see changed now?
- What is your vision for the area?
- What is it about the area that you love?
- What are your concerns about the future?
- What changes would you wish to see in the next 10 years?

### **Objectives of the Lake Plan**

- Maintain or improve the quality of life on the lake by communicating with all stakeholders to determine concerns, issues, interests, potential obstacles and possible remedies;
- Develop a series of recommendations for **issues identified in the survey** and subsequent workshops for stewardship and land use;
- Identify principles and targets to ensure the future health of the lake and watershed;
- Review water quality status and trends and recommend measurement of indicators for environmental health;
- Evaluate current land use policy on a watershed scale and recommend changes to policies and regulations to improve and protect lake assets.
- Prepare action plans and targets relating to each recommendation for land use, stewardship approaches, education and communication;

The following is a description of the **Six Stages of Lake Development** that was discussed at the FOCA (Federation of Cottage Associations) Spring Seminar 2002. Place an X in the box beside the Stage you think best describes your lake.

### **Six Stages of Lake Development**

#### **Stage 1**

A single road is brought to the shoreline at a single access point. A few cottagers are clustered at the access point.

#### **Stage 2**

A marina is built at the access point and water access lots are opened up. The shoreline is quickly developed to about 30%

#### **Stage 3**

Road access is developed to most of the shoreline (where accessible) and the shoreline develops to capacity within 1 to 3 generations.

#### **Stage 4**

Driveways, cottage additions, garages, boat houses, docks, lawns and changes to the natural shoreline are constructed. Loss of habitat, runoff filters, wildlife and diminished dark skies become increasingly evident. Buildings & structures dominate the shoreline. Boat traffic and Jet Ski traffic increase.

#### **Stage 5**

Full density of the shoreline is achieved with remaining natural shoreline compromised, a further decline in water quality and clarity occurs. Possibly more commercial business is added.

#### **Stage 6**

Back lot development and infrastructure changes occur and the lake takes on a look of urban development.

## **Frequently Asked Questions –FAQ's**

### **What is Lake planning?**

Lake planning is a community based planning process that considers the interests of all stakeholders in a lake community, including shoreline residents, commercial operators, forestry managers, lake users ( anglers, hunters, boaters, snowmobilers, area residents who use the lake, campers etc.)

### **Why do Skootamatta, Sheldrake and Pringle need a Lake Plan?**

There are several stages to the development of a lake from its wilderness state. If allowed to go unchecked the lake environment can end up looking much like the urban environment that many lake users are seeking to escape. Our lakes have not suffered to the degree some others are already experiencing, thus we wish to determine through our surveys and subsequent analysis ways to approach inevitable change that best serve the interests of our community as a whole.

### **What is in a Lake Plan?**

Typically a plan identifies issues relating to land-use, water, recreation and resource management. A well developed plan provides detailed action oriented recommendations to land use policy (official plans, zoning by-laws etc.) and stewardship practices. It utilizes approaches such as an education and communication plan as well as necessary restoration projects (i.e. Planting native shoreline filtering plants where they have been eradicated.)

### **Why are we developing a Lake plan when there is an Official Plan for the Township?**

This is a community survey to better understand if there are collective issues we may decide to discuss with Council. There are also identified actions within a Lake plan that are within the jurisdiction of all community dwellers to implement and not included in any Official Plan and are achieved solely through voluntary commitment to stewardship practices.

### **Who is involved in creating a `Lake Plan?**

The lake planning process provides local property owners and a full range of other stakeholders in the community with an opportunity to identify, confirm and protect important ecological and social values and to set common sustainable objectives for a lake and its immediate environment. For Skootamatta, Pringle and Sheldrake a Committee of volunteers was established at the last AGM. From that group a Steering Committee will evolve to develop our Plan using input from surveys such as this and other means of communication by which opinions and input will be sought and vetted.

**How much will a Lake Plan Cost?**

The greatest cost is one of volunteering time and commitment by people on our lakes. There will be a financial cost as well in the creation of a Lake Plan document along with the costs of soliciting input, opinions and information via mailings etc. A cost analysis/estimate will be included in the feedback to this survey *which serves to measure the level of interest and commitment to such an undertaking.*

**Who decides what recommendations are included in the Lake Plan?**

The lake planning process is designed to collect views of all stakeholders and to reflect a consensus view that will carry weight with those in a position to make decisions affecting the lake, such as our local Council, Quinte Conservation Authority and MNR but most importantly our own residents. The Lake Plan Steering Committee will develop draft recommendations based on the input received and will seek approval of these from members of our respective Ratepayer Associations.

**Have other Cottage Associations produced Lake Plans?**

Yes, for example lakes to the east of us and in affiliation with Rideau Conservation Authority and the Tay Valley Watershed have developed Lake Plans. The Muskoka Lakes have had plans developed, in some cases, for many years. Numerous lakes in the Haliburton area have completed or are undertaking lake plans and this questionnaire is based upon ones developed by several lake associations who are actively involved. Cottage Life magazine is interested in the process for all lakes and FOCA (Federation of Cottage Associations) is planning to bring out a template of activities this year which we will gratefully utilize.

**Do Lake Plans make a difference?**

Yes, in several ways. First they build a sense of community and common purpose and allow people to identify and work toward the solution of shared problems and issues. Secondly, they have been cited at municipal hearings for building permits and related development activities. There are instances where the values identified in a Lake Plan caused applications for development that were in conflict with the existing Lake Plan to be denied.

**What if Lake Skootamatta, Pringle and Sheldrake had no Lake Plan?**

The SDRA and Sheldrake Associations believe that the process of creating a Plan is as important as the Plan itself, as it helps us build our sense of community. However, there is real value in completing a formal Plan because these have proven to be valuable in having people identify priorities and to take action. There is also an anticipated outcome or downside in not developing a Plan. It might attract developers with the least interest in the environmental well-being of the area if they believe that our Associations are unorganized, interest in environmental issues low and our controls are lax.

**Why do the SDRA and Sheldrake Lake Association have to pay costs for the Lake Plan?**

In an ideal world such a plan would have the support of the entire community and therefore the financial support of the entire municipality. The current reality for the majority of lakes in cottage country is that few if any other stakeholders will contribute. By financing our Plan for the Skootamatta watershed the members of the SDRA and SLA are further establishing themselves as a leading voice of responsibility for the stewardship of the area.

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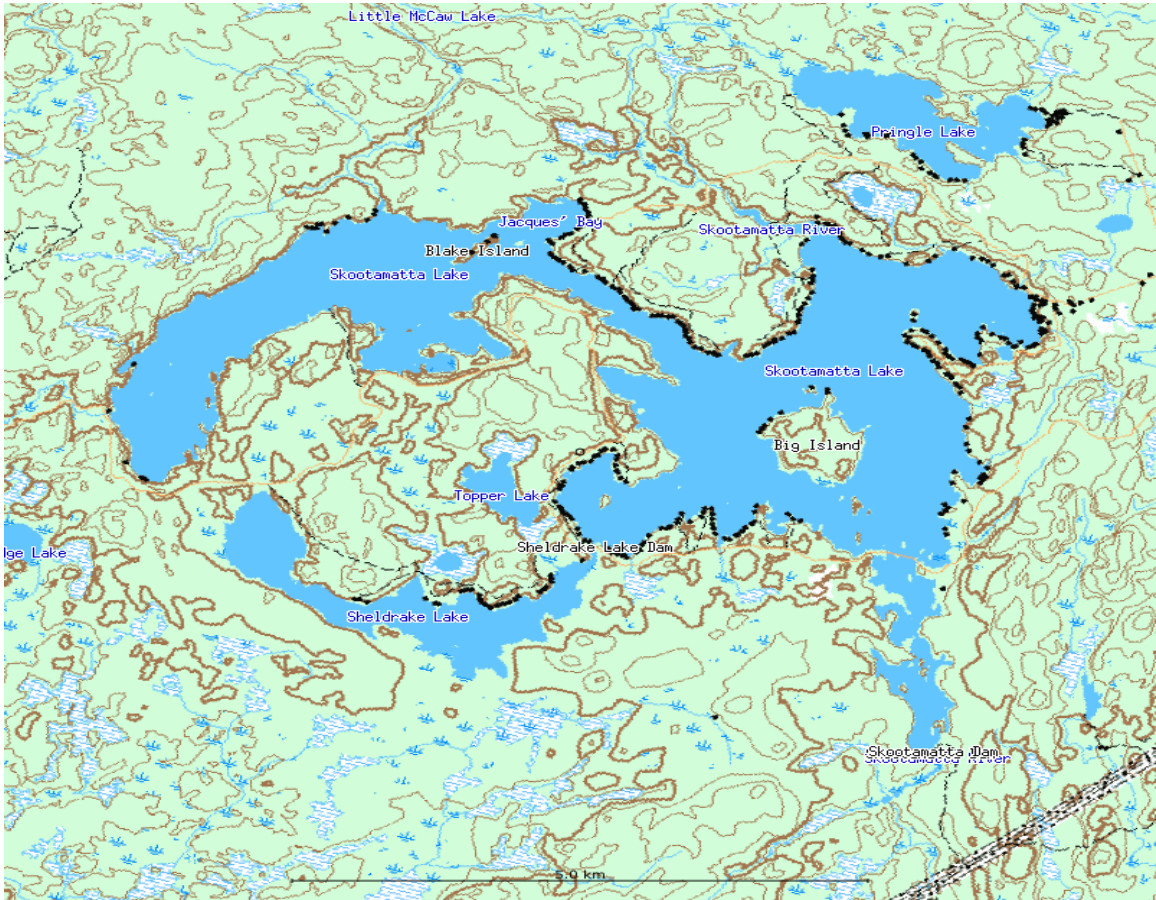
