## 2010 Municipal Election Notice

Pursuant to Sec 37(1) of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996 ("MEA") Henry Hogg has been declared "elected by acclamation" to the position of Reeve for the Corporation of the Township of Addington Highlands for a four (4) year term of Council Commencing December 1, 2010.

An election shall be held on October 25, 2010 to select two (2) Councillors for each of Wards 1 & 2, respectively.

**Qualified electors in Ward 1** may vote for any two (2) of the following candidates:

### **Voter Qualifications:**

You qualify to vote if:

- You are at least 18 years old on election Day, October 25, 2010
- You are a Canadian Citizen
- You or your spouse lives, rents or owns property in the Township and
- You are not otherwise prohibited by law from voting.

### **Voter Information Letter**

Each person on the Voter's List shall be mailed, by "first class" mail, a sealed Voter Information Letter during the first week of October containing voting instructions. If you have not received such a letter by October 15, call the Township office immediately.

### **Voting**

Eligible voters shall: i) be required to telephone a designated toll free number or access a designated internet address and cast their votes, ii) be limited to only one vote through the use of a designated PIN. Voting runs from 8 AM on Oct 15 to 8 PM Oct 25, 2010.
